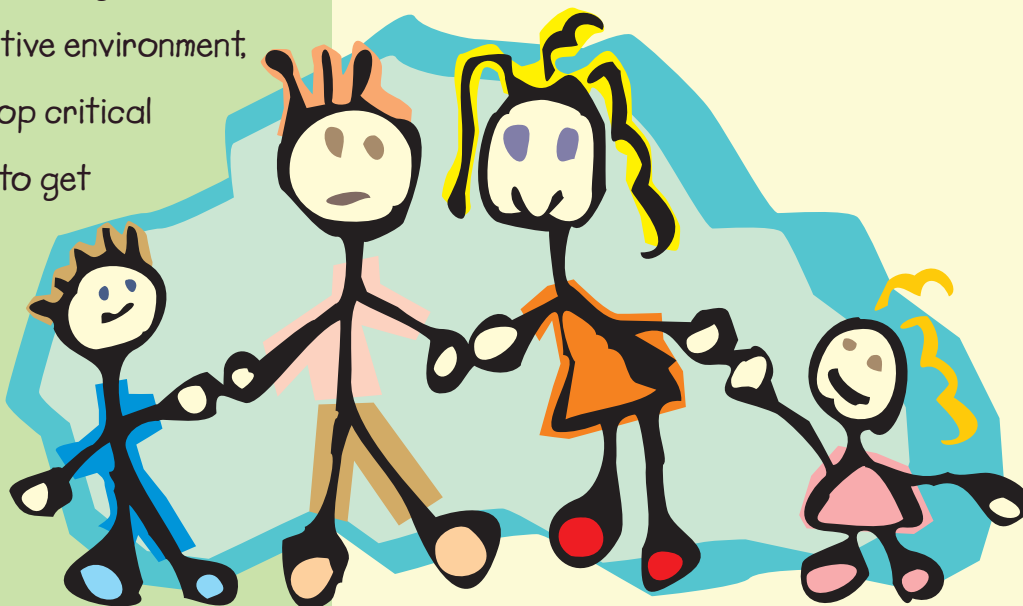


our philosophy

what parent participation means

Parent Participation Preschools (PPPs) are non-profit schools founded and run by parents and licensed by the Community Care Facilities Board. PPPs comply with all health, safety, and educational and training requirements. Inglewood PPP is a member of the Council of Parent Participation Preschools in BC.

requirements:

About twice a month, parents/caregivers participate in a "duty day" at the preschool. During this time, you assist the teacher with preschool activities. Our teacher is especially trained to guide parents with their duties as classroom assistants. This is usually a special day for both you and your child, and a rare experience only possible at a PPP.

Each family gets to sign up for a job needed to operate and maintain the preschool. This gives you an opportunity to utilize your existing skills, develop new skills and socialize in a new and interesting setting.

Parents participate in monthly general meetings in order to comply with the educational and childcare requirements of a PPP, as well as attend to the general business of running the preschool.

Families get the chance to participate in family special events and fundraising activities. Since parents organize these events, they often involve activities that most families enjoy.

benefits:

Have the opportunity to participate in the classroom with your child normally twice a month. This provides a higher than required adult to child ratio (max. 1:5 for the 3s class and 1:6 for the 4s class).

Make decisions about the operation of your child's preschool by being directly involved.

Broaden your knowledge and experience in child-raising through workshops, discussions and guest speakers at monthly meetings.

Be part of a community of like-minded people, who together value the basic philosophy of parent-child involvement.

Cultivate life-long friendships.

our history

Inglewood PPP has been in continuous operation since 1947 — longer than any other preschool group in the Lower Mainland! It began by a group of mothers who intuitively felt that their involvement in their child's education was essential. Today, Inglewood PPP has evolved into a very unique experience. Parents work together with the teacher to provide a nurturing, creative and stimulating preschool experience. More than 1,000 North Shore families have been a part of Inglewood PPP. Parents who attended the school themselves are now sending their children here. Inglewood PPP is truly a family- and community-oriented preschool, with a proud, ongoing legacy.

our facilities

Our classroom is large and bright and equipped with various learning centres. In our room you will find the circle time mat, where we start and end our day, including scheduled lively news updates from the children. We also have a "living space" equipped with a pretend kitchen, bedroom and dress-up area as well as numerous other play stations including art and puzzle tables; music area; reading corner; water and sand tables; science and carpentry tables; and indoor climbing gym. Our school also has a small kitchen where parents prepare shared snacks and where the children often take part in cooking and baking activities. Our own private playground has climbing, biking and wooded areas to exercise both the body and imagination!
